The Avon Club

The Avon Club is a social and community service organization with membership open to women age 18 or over who live or work in the Avonworth School District. Avon Club holds a number of activities designed to raise funds for location nonprofits and community groups. Some of these activities include:

- Fall Festival: A street fair in downtown Ben Avon that features crafters, food, music and fun. It is usually held in late September or early October on a Saturday.
- **House Tour:** Avon Club has hosted a number of house tours that feature leading homes in Ben Avon. Last year's tour was during the Christmas season.
- **Avon Eaters:** Approximately four times a year, members of Avon Club and their spouses meet at local homes for an elaborate dinner and libations.
- Avonworth Scholarship: Each year, the Club presents two deserving young women a college scholarship.
